- 1. Graduating seniors from Dunkirk High School.
- 2. Students planning to attend a 2 year or 4 year Catholic college/university.

Criteria for selecting recipients

- 1. Participation in volunteer activities related to their church, faith, or community.
- 2. Those of Polish descent will have preference, but all others will be considered.
