Brocton Central School	Students Working with Veterans	Students learn about the experiences of veterans and the importance of Memorial Day by working with veterans to place flags in Portland Cemetery.
Cassadaga Valley Central School	Cassadaga Cares	Students learn about the various community volunteer groups and the people they serve by collaborating with them to coordinate fundraising events throughout the year.
Cassadaga Valley Central School	Cougar Nation	Students learn healthy ways to deal with stress, loneliness, and confrontation and promote positivity and support throughout the school and community through artistic mediums.
Cassadaga Valley Central School	Kindness is Key	Students learn about the elderly at the local nursing home and through the club's motto "to serve others", create care packages that spread kindness.
E2CCB LoGuidice Center	E Brew Coffee Shop & Lounge	Students visit staff offices and take calls to prepare and serve food orders. They develop important job skills such as math and interpersonal skills.
E2CCB LoGuidice Center	Community Policing and Education	Students study various safety precautions for young children and receive an introduction to the criminal justice field. Students organize events to teach younger children about safety in an interactive way.

Students learn to develop activities and interactions to meet the social, emotional, and developmental needs of the special education students.

Fredonia Central School	Canvas and Cans	Students learn to organize an event where they create a painting, and teach others to recreate that painting in a detailed way. Food items will be collected for the food bank from all those that participate in the event.
