2. Student must meet eligibility requirements.
3. Applicant may be asked to be interviewed by the Committee.
4. Guidance Departments & recipients will be notified by May 15th.

Who is eligible to apply?

1. Student must be graduating from one of the following school districts:
Brocton, Cassadaga, Chautauqua Lake, Dunkirk, Forestville, Fredonia,
Pine Valley, Ripley, Silver Creek or Westfield.
2. Student must be pursuing an education in the trades, manufacturing technology, Auto technology or Body repairs.

3. Demonstration that he/she has worked to his/her potential in high school
